HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS

High school courses are for students who want to: upgrade existing marks, complete pre-requisite courses, and/or fast-track their high school program.

JUNIOR HIGH PROGRAMS

Language Arts (grades 7-9) & Math (grades 7-9). Junior high courses are for students who want to improve their knowledge of the basic concepts in a particular subject. There are limited spaces and early registration is encouraged.

ATTENDANCE/WORKLOAD

These courses come with a heavy workload, including daily homework assignments and less time for completion. A class period of 3.25 hours for high school and 2 hours for junior high is equivalent to approximately 1 week of regular classes. Due to the compressed nature of our program, the following rules apply:

- Students will be withdrawn from classes after 3 absences.
- If students miss class due to illness, they must contact the teacher and arrange to catch up outside of class.
- **DO NOT register for Summer School if you know you will miss some classes.**
- **If students miss due to illness, they must contact the teacher to make arrangements to catch up outside of class time.**
